Activities Accomplished by Curriculum Development Center

Pokhara University (PU) was established in 1997 under the Pokhara University Act, 1997. The Curriculum Development Center is established under section 19 of Pokhara University Act 2053 in 2069 BS. The main objective of Curriculum Development Centre is to develop curricula of all the programs of the university. The main functions of the CDC are as follows:

- design and develop curriculum.
- revise the existing curriculum as per the national and international need.
- organize training, workshop, seminar etc. related to curriculum design and development.
- develop teaching pedagogies and evaluation tools.
- organize various refresher & orientation programs to enhance & upgrade teaching-learning practices.
- develop books and reference materials.
- conduct small scale research projects to explore new trends & dimensions of higher studies.

The Curriculum Development Centre (CDC) has accomplished the following achievements since its inception.

Collection and Compilation of the Curriculum

Before the establishment of the Curriculum Development Centre, the faculties had the record of the curriculum of few common programs only. There was a trend that the concerned college used to develop the curriculum of the program and university did not have any record of that curriculum. Immediately after the establishment, the Curriculum Development Centre has collected all these scattered documents and compiled them to form complete curriculum of the concerned program. Now, the CDC has the hard copies and electronic copies of the curriculum of all the programs.

Curriculum Structure Revision of Old Programs

The Curriculum Development Centre has revised the curriculum structure of the following programs.

1. **Engineering Programs:** Before the establishment of the Curriculum Development Centre, the Faculty of Science and Technology had already developed the detail syllabus of all the courses taught in first and second semesters of all the engineering programs. However, this process started without developing the detailed curriculum structure (four year structure) of these programs. The CDC has developed the curriculum structure of these programs immediately after its establishment.

- i) Bachelor of Civil Engineering
 - ii) Bachelor of Electrical & Electronics Engineering
 - iii) Bachelor of Electronics & Communication Engineering
 - iv) Bachelor of Computer Engineering
 - v) Bachelor of Software Engineering, and
 - vi) Bachelor of Engineering in Information Technology
2. **Bachelor of Computer Application:** Before the establishment of the Curriculum Development Centre, the Faculty of Science and Technology had already developed the detail syllabus of all the courses taught in first and second semesters. However, this process started without developing the detailed curriculum structure (four year structure) of this program. The CDC has developed the curriculum structure of this program immediately after its establishment.
3. **Management Programs:** The Management Subject of the university had already developed the draft copy of the revised curriculum structure of the following programs before the establishment of CDC. The CDC has organised workshops to collect the feedbacks of the concerned faculties on the draft curriculum structure. These workshops were very much fruitful to finalize the curriculum structure of the following programs.
- i) Bachelor of Business Administration
 - ii) Bachelor of Business Administration in Banking and Insurance
 - iii) Bachelor of Business Administration in Travel and Tourism
 - iv) Bachelor of Computer Information System

5. **Master of Science in Natural Resources Management:** This program started as 18 month program in 2000 and continued till 2014. The Curriculum Development Centre has revised its curriculum structure and developed this as a 2 year program in 2013.
6. **Master of Science in Construction Management:** This program started as 18 month program in 2000 and continued till 2013. The Curriculum Development Centre has revised its curriculum structure and developed this as a 2 year program in 2013.
